2018 NWSEO Election Nomination Deadline

(June 1, 2018) This is a reminder that nominations for Regional Chair, Regional Vice Chair, Steward, Vice Steward, Delegate and Alternate Delegate are due today.

A Recap of NOMINATION PROCEDURES

Branch Steward/Vice Steward Nominations – If you are a member in good standing of a branch, you may nominate yourself or any other member in good standing from your local branch for the position of branch steward or vice steward. **Nominations must be in writing, dated and signed by the member making the nomination and presented to your local branch Steward and Regional Chair by June 1, 2018.**

Regional Officer Nominations – Also due in writing postmarked by June 1, 2018. If you have been a member of NWSEO since September 2017, you may nominate yourself to run as a candidate for any regional office. Regardless of how long you have been a NWSEO member, you may nominate any other union member in your region as a candidate for regional officer, provided that the person you nominate has been a member since September 2017. If you nominate someone for regional chair/vice chair, please contact your nominee to ensure they accept the nomination.
